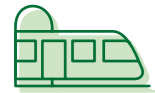

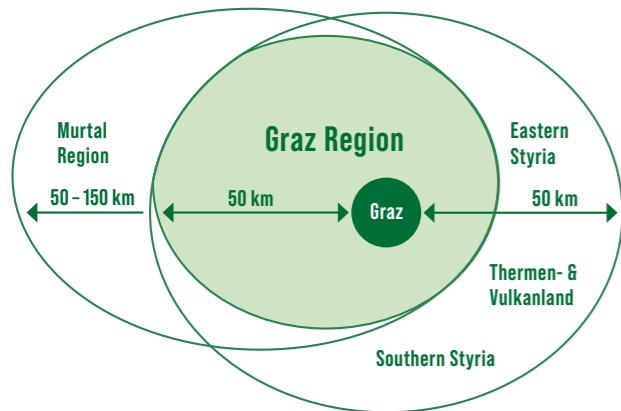

The travel time to the sights (by car) is between a few minutes and one hour at the most.



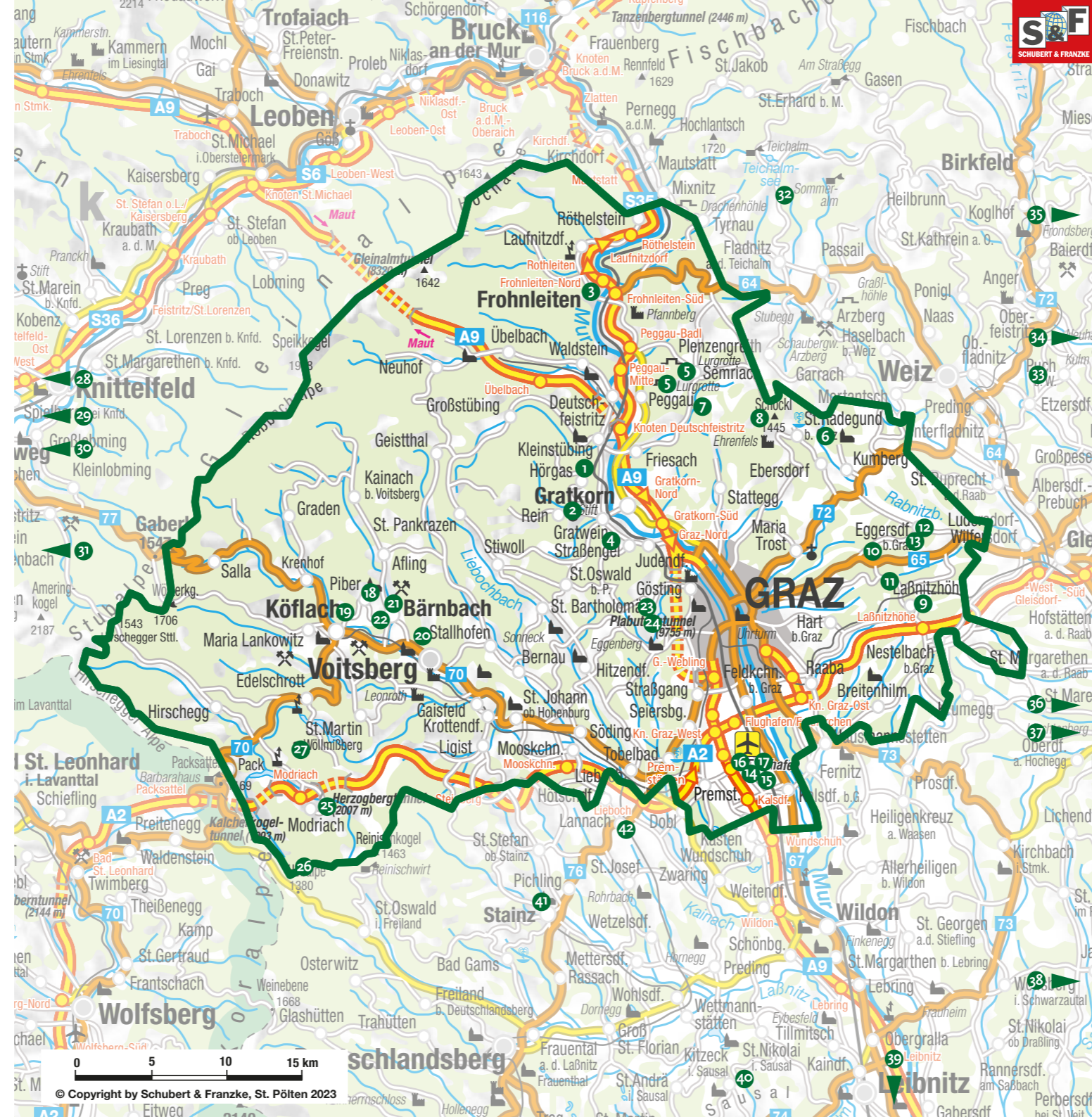

The R2 Mur Cycle Path is a key fixture in the north. In the Graz Region it wends its way from Frohnleiten to Graz before heading further south. It links up several sights which makes it ideal for exploring the region by bicycle.

Austrian Open-Air Museum Stübing



AUSTRIAN OPEN-AIR MUSEUM STÜBING

Enjoy the idyllic surrounding of the open-air museum in Stübing. Wander through Austria from the Burgenland to the Vorarlberg regions and learn about the building methods and ways of life as well as the typical regional tools from bygone days. This world of rural life and work lives on in a quiet tributary valley of the river Mur and consists of around one hundred original rural buildings spanning six centuries.

REIN ABBEY

Approximately 20 km north of Graz lies the baroque monastery complex of Rein. Cistercian monks have lived here continuously since 1129. This makes it the oldest Cistercian monastery still in existence in the world. The baroque abbey church radiates sublime beauty, the library is home to impressive medieval manuscripts from the monastery's own scriptorium, and the extensive monastery woods are an invitation for strolls and walks.

MARIA STRASSENGEL PILGRIMAGE CHURCH

The small church settlement of Maria Straßengel rises on a hill, visible from afar, just a few kilometres north of Graz. A fortified wall encloses the rectory, the taverna, the Baroque “new building” and the pilgrimage church, which with its tower is one of the most important high gothic religious buildings in Austria. By the way: a varied walk with wonderful viewpoints leads from the ruins of Gösting castle in Graz to Maria Straßengel.

LURGROTTE CAVE IN PEGGAU & SEMRIACH



Lurgrotte cave is the largest dripstone stalactite cave in Austria. Surface water has been seeping into the cave which the Lurbach river has eroded into the limestone rock for millions of years, constantly depositing limestone and forming impressive, fragile and powerful works of art. Visitors can immerse themselves in this fascinating world from either Peggau or Semriach.

Lights and sounds at the Lurgrotte cave, Semriach

A light show allows the largest stalactite cave in the world to shine in a completely new light. The special light effects reveal a true cosmos of shapes and colours which remained hidden until relatively recently.

Prehistoric Museum at Lurgrotte cave, Peggau

The Prehistoric Museum has been situated at the Lurgrotte cave in Peggau since 2019. On entering the Lurgrotte in Peggau on their journey into prehistory, visitors encounter the skeleton of a cave bear, a mammoth's tusk and plants that apparently grow without daylight.

SPRING TRAILS



22 architecturally artistic springs in St. Radegund bei Graz can be explored on a variety of circular trails. The artworks bear the names of aristocratic benefactors, visitors to the spa and the great spa doctors of the 19th and 20th centuries. With its steep slopes and extensive plateau, the Schöckl (1,445 m) is a very special experience for mountain biking and downhill freaks (Schöckl Trail Area) as well as for hikers. The “trails and a motor skills course for everyone” (including activity and fitness equipment for wheelchair users), a disc golf trail, a nature play path, an orienteering route and the “Hexenexpress” summer toboggan run are also very popular.

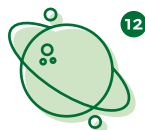

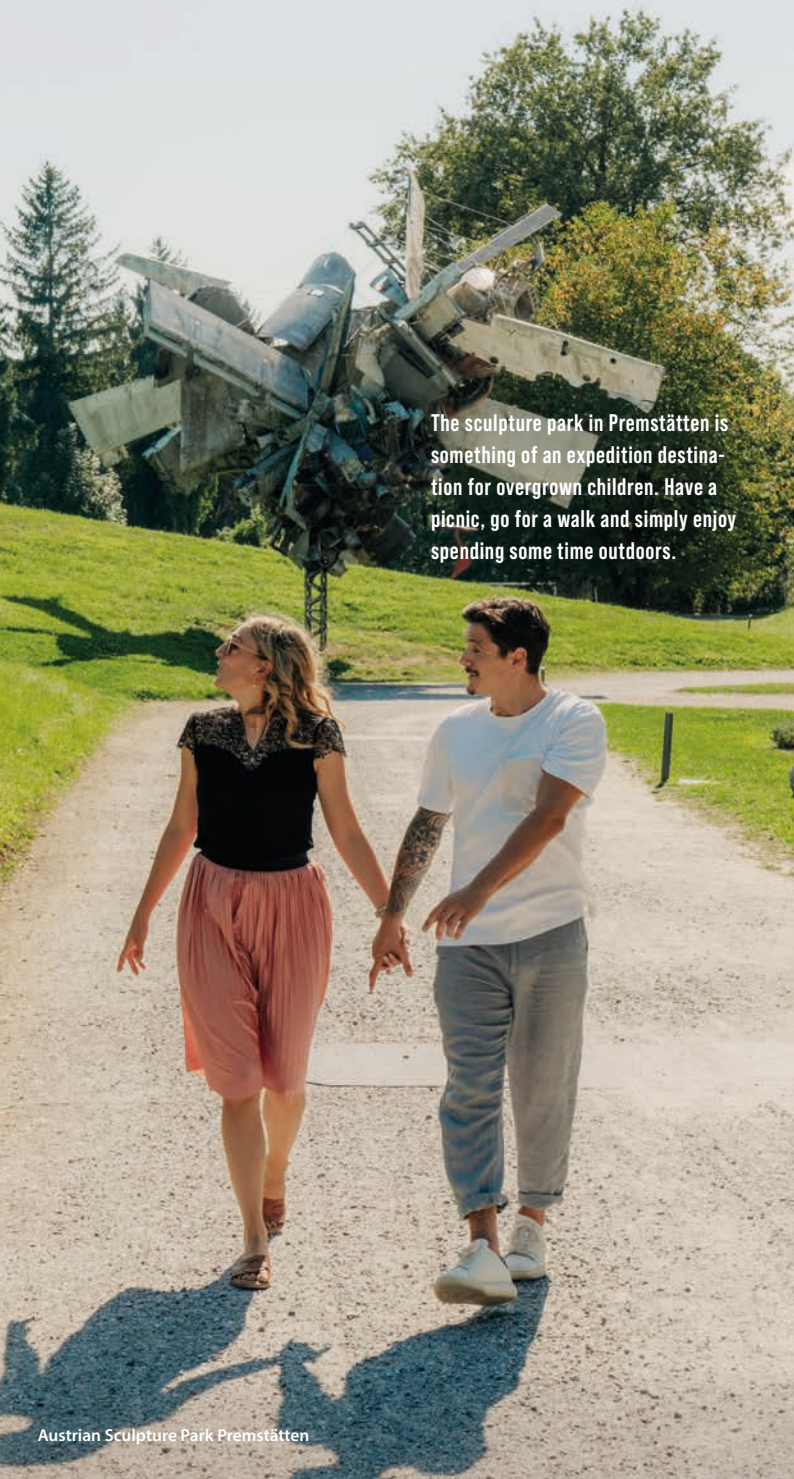

AUSTRIAN SCULPTURE PARK



Since its foundation in 2003, the Austrian Sculpture Park has established itself as a centre for contemporary sculpture. The fascinating park designed by landscape architect Dieter Kienast covers an area of approximately seven hectares, and is home to more than 80 sculptures. Works by well-known artists from Austria combine with examples of international sculpture. By the way: the park has also been rated by the Guardian as one of the 10 best sculpture parks in Europe, and is also free to visit!
